



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SUNDAY, AUGUST 2, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

*A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas.* All residents and visitors are advised to remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities, and seek shaded and well ventilated areas during peak hours between 11am to 4pm.

Mid to upper-level troughing continue to generate the weather across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. A surface trough along with a tropical wave will drift westward maintaining cloudy skies and stormy conditions over the Northern and parts of the Central Bahamas through tonight. Saharan Dust is suppressing shower activity across the Southeastern Bahamas today, while high pressure remains across the islands supporting a gentle to moderate breeze.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: This unsettled pattern will hold across the Northern Bahamas and portions of the Northwest Bahamas through early next week as moisture continues to stream across the area and troughing persists. By Tuesday, a second tropical wave tracking south of the island chain is forecast to induce troughing across the Southeast and Central Bahamas, resulting in another uptick in showers and thunderstorms. Later in the week, a disturbance moving in from the east may renew unsettled conditions across the island chain ahead of the weekend.

Severe Weather Risk: *There is a **moderate to high** risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms, particularly across the Northern Bahamas.* These storms are capable of producing **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**.
The public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a **moderate** risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas, mainly across the **Northern Bahamas**, especially during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of rip currents for the Atlantic coastal waters of the Bahamas archipelago and east and southeast sheltered coastal waters of parts of the Central and the entire Southeast Bahamas.

UV Index: Members of the public across **The Bahamas** are still advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **high to very high** range.

PRECIPITATION:	30 to 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION: 20 to 40% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of an isolated shower or thunderstorm.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next 7 days.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Variably cloudy
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 40 to 50% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knot, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the evening hours.
WINDS: Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Variably cloudy
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with occasional higher gusts, becoming east to southeast by the evening
WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern Bahamas: Variably cloudy
Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts
WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast by the evening hours.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny.

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Elsewhere: 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours
Elsewhere: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

PRECIPITATION: Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, becoming northeast to east by the evening hours, decreasing to 10 to 15 knots overnight.

WINDS: Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, becoming northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by the evening
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, becoming southeast to south by the afternoon, falling light and variable at times
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots
