



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, SUNDAY, JUNE 28, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

### WARNING IN EFFECT:

A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of **Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands**). *The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.*

While a broad high pressure system sits across the Bahamas, pockets of moisture will produce streaming showers and short lived thunderstorms today. This is due to a weakening surface trough, moving westward, across the Southeastern Islands and another over Florida. Hot and humid conditions with slight to moderate seas are spread throughout the country.

### GENERAL SITUATION:

**Outlook:** The trough will dissipate by Monday, as the ridge briefly strengthens over the area. A late season cold front will descend in Atlantic waters just north of the Bahamas, allowing winds to fall light and variable while increasing rain chances across the northern territories. Another tropical wave is anticipated to pass just south of the island chain by mid-week, interacting with a deep layered trough in the Northern Islands, allowing instances of showers and thunderstorms to become more widespread as the wave continues westward. This unstable pattern will hold through to Friday as the front lifts northward. Expect increasingly stable conditions to take hold by the weekend.

**Rip Currents:** A **slight** to **moderate** risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines of the island chain. **Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.**

### SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

**UV Index:** Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range.

**PRECIPITATION:** 20 to 40% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms  
**WINDS:** Easterly at 15 to 20 knots gusting in the late afternoon and early evening.

**TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:**

**1. Off shore the Southeastern U.S. Coast:**  
A broad low pressure area is expected to form offshore of the southeastern coast of the United States on Monday or Tuesday. The formation of this system has a low 20 percent (20%) through the next seven (7) days.

**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 29<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2026.**

**SKY CONDITIONS:** All areas: Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night.  
**PRECIPITATION:** All areas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.  
**WINDS:** Northern Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable during the afternoon.  
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable in the Northwest Bahamas.  
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, shifting northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.

Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.  
Northern Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.  
**WINDS:** Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.  
Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

**PRECIPITATION:** Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.  
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.  
Northern Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.  
**WINDS:** Northwest and Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 knots, falling light and variable at times.  
Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts.
