BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, THURSDAY, JULY 2, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A lingering surface trough combined with abundant moisture will support an unsettled weather pattern across the Northern Bahamas throughout the period, as the trough gradually lifts northward. Elsewhere, the presence of high pressure and Saharan dust will help to suppress shower and thunderstorm activity across the remainder of the area through tonight.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Persistent troughing across the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas will continue to support an increased chance of showers and thunderstorms through Friday, while a plume of Saharan dust suppresses shower and thunderstorm activity across the Central and Southeast Bahamas. By late Friday, a tropical wave accompanied by an upper-level disturbance will approach from the east, increasing moisture and instability across the region. As a result, shower and thunderstorm activity is expected to become more widespread over the weekend, even as high pressure strengthens across the archipelago.

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a *slight* to *moderate* risk of a few severe thunderstorms that may impact portions of the **Northern Bahamas** today. *Residents are urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flooding: There is a *slight* risk of flooding in low-lying, flood prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall events. All residents, especially in the **Northern Bahamas**, are urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas.

Rip Currents: A *slight* to *moderate* risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines tonight and through the next several days. Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS**

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

WINDS: Easterly at 15 knots with higher gusts.
