BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, THURSDAY, APRIL 9, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>There are currently no public warnings or watches in effect at this time. A Near-gale warning (28-33 knots) is in effect for the Northern Bahamas as well as portions of the Northwest Bahamas (Northern Andros, Berry Islands, Northern Eleuthera). GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>A few pops of showers and thunderstorms remain possible along a slow-moving frontal boundary and weakening pre-frontal trough across the Bahamas throughout the period. Outside of these isolated areas, the risk of severe weather will gradually diminish, as a drier air mass filters in from the west. Meanwhile, high pressure will progressively build across the northern territories, supporting brisk winds and fast-moving showers in its wake through tonight.</p> <p>Outlook: By Friday, the frontal boundary will continue to weaken as it drifts into the Central Bahamas, leading to an uptick in showers across those islands, eventually reaching the Southeast Bahamas on Saturday. Following its passage, high pressure will build in its wake, leading to more stable conditions and fresh to strong breezes with near gale gusts across most of the island chain through the weekend and into early next week.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents: There is a high risk of rip currents for all Atlantic coastal waters and passages across the entire island chain. <i>Swimmers are advised to refrain from entering these waters and to exercise extreme caution when crossing the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera until further notice.</i></p> <p>Flash Flooding: There is a marginal risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas across the Southeast Bahamas tonight, due to heavy and prolonged rainfall events. <i>Residents are urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas.</i></p>

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 – 40% chance of showers this afternoon, decreasing 10 – 30% tonight.		
WINDS:	Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):			
SKY CONDITIONS:	A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, becoming partly cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms near the front this afternoon, decreasing to a 10 – 20% chance of showers late tonight.		
WINDS:	Variable at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, veering northeast to east at 15 to 25 knots behind the front. Expect gusts to near gale in the areas of Northern Andros, the Berry islands, and North Eleuthera.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS (INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight. Expect a few patches of clouds to drift into the area by late tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 – 30% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	South to southwest at 10 knots or less this afternoon. Expect winds to veer northwest to north at 10 knots or less as the front approaches by this evening. Winds will shift north to northeast at 15 knots by tonight.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):			
SKY CONDITIONS:	A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, turning mostly cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms, mainly in the vicinity of the trough this afternoon, increasing 30 – 50% tonight.		
WINDS:	Variable at 10 knots or less this afternoon, shifting north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots tonight.

SKY CONDITIONS:	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny during the day becoming fair at night <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> Mix of sun and clouds during the morning hours, becoming partly sunny by afternoon and mainly fair at night. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> a mix of sun and clouds during the day, and variably cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> 10 to 20% chance of shower <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> 20 to 30% chance of showers. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> 10 to 30% chance during the morning hours increasing to 20 to 40% chance by late evening.		
WINDS:	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale (mainly across the northern islands of the Northwest Bahamas) during the morning hours, with winds Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the other areas. <i>Central Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> East to southeast at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, shifting northeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts behind the front. Expect winds to become light and variable at times in the vicinity of the front.

SKY CONDITIONS:	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny, becoming variably cloudy at night. <i>Northwest and Central Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> Variably cloudy with gradual clearing, becoming mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	<i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms. <i>Elsewhere:</i> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	<i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by the evening hours. <i>Elsewhere:</i> Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, increasing 20 to 25 knots with potential gusts to near gale-force (mainly across the Northwest and Central Bahamas) by the afternoon hours.
