## **BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST**

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There remains a marginal risk for a few isolated strong to possibly severe thunderstorms particularly across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas today through tonight. These storms have the potential to produce strong gusty winds, heavy downpours, frequent lightning, and possible waterspout and/or tornadic activity.
GENERAL SITUATION:	An unsettled weather pattern will continue mainly across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas today courtesy of a remnant frontal trough and deep tropical moisture in place supported by mid to upper level troughing across the area. Meanwhile, surface high pressure will maintain moderate breezes across the island chain.  Outlook: Showers and thunderstorms will continue across portions of the Bahamas for the weekend due to lingering troughing across the area with a gradual decrease in activity into next week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flooding: There is an elevated risk of ponding of water on roadways and localized flooding in low lying or flood prone areas during heavy downpours showers or prolonged rainfall events.

*Eastern Tropical Atlantic:* A tropical wave is forecast to move off the west coast of Africa by Friday morning. Some slow development of this system is possible over the weekend through the middle of next week while it moves west-northwestward across the eastern and central tropical Atlantic. Formation chance through 7 days is a low 20 percent. Elsewhere tropical cyclone activity is not expected through the next 7 days.
