



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, THURSDAY, MAY 28, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time. For additional marine information, please view our Marine forecast on our website, met.gov.bs.

Dry, stable and slightly hazy conditions will persist for this afternoon, as a deep layered ridging pattern remains as the dominant weather feature. Increasing cloudiness along with an uptick in shower chances will affect portions of the northern territories beginning this evening, as a surge of moisture ahead of a late season cold front gradually infiltrates the area tonight.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The high pressure ridge will shift eastward late tonight allowing rich, tropical moisture to move into the area from the Caribbean Sea. This developing pattern will support cloudier skies, increasing shower and thunderstorm chances, mainly across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas through the weekend. Unsettled weather is expected to continue through into next week, particularly across the northern half of the country, as additional tropical moisture moves into the area along with a prefrontal trough.

Rip Currents: There is a **moderate** risk of dangerous rip currents along all east coast and Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. **Beachgoers and swimmers should exercise caution.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat and UV Index: Residents across **The Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range and heat indices can reach the **triple digits**.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon. Expect increasingly cloudy conditions beginning this evening, turning cloudy to occasionally overcast mainly across Bimini and Grand Bahama tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of showers, with the possibility of offshore thunderstorms near Bimini and West Grand Bahama this afternoon through to this evening, increasing 20 – 30% tonight.

WINDS: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair this evening. Expect increasingly cloudy conditions overnight.

PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.

WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with occasionally higher gusts.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.

WINDS: Easterly at 15 knots.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.*

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY, 29TH MAY 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy with a few overcast periods during the day, remaining partly cloudy to cloudy at night.
Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming partly cloudy to cloudy at night.
Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming variably to partly cloudy overnight.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** 30 – 40% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms.
Central Bahamas: 10 - 20% chance of isolated showers.
Southeast Bahamas: 20 - 30% chance of isolated showers.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** South to southwest at 10 – 15 knots with higher gusts.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less.
Central & Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 – 15 knots with higher gusts.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY, 30TH MAY 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **All Areas:** Cloudy with some overcast periods.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** 30 – 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central & Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of isolated showers or thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** South to southwest at 15 to 20 knots, becoming southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by the evening hours.
Northwest Bahamas: Southwesterly at 10 to 15 knots during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon through evening.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots during the morning hours, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY, 31ST MAY 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Variably cloudy, becoming partly to mostly cloudy by late evening
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy to cloudy

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 50 to 70% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Westerly at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times during the afternoon, becoming southwesterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts during the evening through the overnight hours.

Northwest Bahamas: Variable at less than 10 knots
Central & Southeast Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy to cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers
Elsewhere: 30 to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southwesterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, becoming south to southwest at 15 to 20 knots by the evening
Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less
Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less
Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours
Northwest Bahamas: Southerly at 10 knots or less, becoming southeast to south at 10 knots or less

WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less, increasing to 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours
Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeast at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts.
