BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, THURSDAY, JUNE 4, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Dust Advisory: A **Saharan Dust Advisory** is still in effect for the **Central & Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands**. Air Quality Index (AQI) will be **slight to moderate** for Sensitive Groups, and visibility may be significantly reduced in some areas. *People with respiratory or heart disease, the elderly and children should limit prolonged exposure by remaining indoors and wearing masks during this event.*

GENERAL SITUATION:

Tropical moisture interacting with a frontal boundary across the Northwest and Central Bahamas will continue to maintain cloudy conditions across much of the island chain this afternoon through tonight. This unsettled pattern will support widely scattered showers and thunderstorms mainly across the Central Bahamas, along with isolated shower activity across portions of the Northwest Bahamas. Meanwhile, lingering Saharan dust across the Southeast Bahamas will continue to produce slightly hazy skies while limiting shower development across that region.

Outlook: As we head into the weekend, the frontal boundary is forecast to drift southeastward into the Southeast Bahamas, carrying moisture with it. Meanwhile, Saharan dust over the Southeastern islands will gradually diminish on Friday, allowing shower activity to increase across that region. Shower and thunderstorm chances will remain elevated across the Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas through the start of the new work week as a series of troughs move across the island chain.

Rip Currents: There is a **high** risk of dangerous, **life-threatening** rip currents across the **Northern Bahamas**, especially along north and east coast beaches. **Beachgoers are strongly discouraged from entering the water at this time.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Flood warning: There is a moderate risk of flooding in low-lying and flood prone areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall events. Residents are advised to take the necessary precautions.

A **slight** risk of rip currents exists elsewhere along all Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. Beachgoers should exercise caution when entering the water.

Northwest & Central Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts (mainly across the Northwest and Central Bahamas)
Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots during the day, becoming variable at 10 knots or less by the evening hours.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
