



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, Thursday, June 11, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

The Bahamas remains on the western periphery of a broad ridge of high pressure which continues to drive gentle to moderate easterly breezes across the area while supporting warm, humid conditions. Meanwhile, a dry air mass aloft is acting to suppress significant convection over the region despite the occasional isolated shower or thunderstorm triggered by strong daytime heating.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: High pressure will continue to dominate through the end of the work week, bringing hot temperatures, light winds, and mostly stable weather with limited shower activity. Conditions are expected to change late Saturday as a tropical wave approaches, increasing the chance of showers and thunderstorms across the southern islands. By Sunday, wetter and more unsettled weather is likely across the Southeast Bahamas, with showers and thunderstorms spreading to the rest of the country early next week. High pressure will return behind the system, bringing stronger breezes through midweek.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat and UV Index: Members of the public across **The Bahamas** are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** range and heat indices may reach the **upper 90s**.

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy this afternoon, becoming mostly fair tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 - 30% chance of an isolated afternoon shower or two with a slight chance of an offshore thunderstorm, decreasing to a 10 – 20% chance of showers by this evening through tonight.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, becoming mostly fair tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 - 30% chance of an isolated afternoon shower or two with a slight chance of an offshore thunderstorm, decreasing to a 10 – 20% chance of showers by this evening through tonight.		
WINDS:	Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, becoming partly cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10-20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with slightly higher gusts at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

A broad area of low pressure is likely to form over the Bay of Campeche on Friday from a westward-moving tropical wave currently located over the Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico. Environmental conditions are forecast to be only marginally conducive for development before the system moves inland over eastern Mexico late Saturday or Sunday. This system has a *low, or 10% chance of tropical cyclone development within the next seven (7) days.*

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 12TH JUNE, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Mix of clouds and sun during the day, mainly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 -20% chance of quick passing showers.
WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts at night.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 93°F – 98°F / 34°C – 37°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 13TH JUNE, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, with increasing cloud coverage by the evening hours.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 - 20% chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 - 30% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 14TH JUNE, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Cloudy to occasionally overcast.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northern Northwest and Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 15TH JUNE, 2026

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair with a few cloudy periods at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
WINDS: Central Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C



EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 16TH JUNE, 2026

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Mostly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a few breaks possible.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 10 – 30% chance of showers.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy with a few breaks possible.

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 knots by nightfall.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with higher gusts.
