BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

*A **Saharan Dust Advisory** is now in effect for the Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands, and will come into effect for the Central Bahamas on Wednesday. Air Quality Index (AQI) will be **Moderate to Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups**, and visibility may be significantly reduced beginning today through to Wednesday. People with respiratory or heart disease, the elderly and children should limit prolonged exposure by remaining indoors and wearing masks during this event.*

A low pressure system situated just west of Bermuda will continue to draw moisture across the northern and central islands throughout the day, encouraging cloudy and humid conditions, while supporting mostly light showers and afternoon thunderstorms. A plume of Saharan dust infiltrating the Southeast Bahamas will allow for hazy conditions this afternoon while limiting rainfall chances within the region tonight.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The northern territories will remain under the influence of streaming moisture, while relatively drier conditions brought upon by Saharan dust continues across the remainder of the area through to midweek. The frontal boundary north of the country is forecast to enter the Northern Bahamas by late Wednesday through early Thursday while weakening. This will lead to an uptick in shower and thunderstorm activity across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as the swath of moisture shifts southward on Thursday. Lingering troughing and residual moisture will continue to keep conditions unsettled across portions of the Bahamas heading into the weekend.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat and UV Index: UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range across portions of the Bahamas today and heat indices may reach the **triple digits**.

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

WINDS:	West to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times by tonight.

PRECIPITATION:	20 – 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	West-southwest to west-northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

SKY CONDITIONS:	A mix of sun and clouds today, turning partly cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 – 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Variable at 10 knots or less, veering east to southeast at 10 knots or less tonight.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.***EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 3RD JUNE 2026.****SKY CONDITIONS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy
Southeast and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy and hazy.**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 30% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Light and variable, becoming northwest to north at 10 knots, before becoming north to northeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts
Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at less than 10 knots, falling light and variable during the afternoon hours, shifting north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots by the evening.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, but 10 to 15 knots across portions of the Southeast Bahamas, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas and east to southeast across the Southeast Bahamas by the evening.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 4TH JUNE 2026.**SKY CONDITIONS:** **Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming mostly fair at night.
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy to cloudy**PRECIPITATION:** **Southeast Bahamas:** 10 to 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots during the morning hours, becoming 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by the afternoon
Northwest Bahamas: Northeasterly at 10 knots or less, increasing to 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by the evening hours.
Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, increasing to 10 to 15 knots across the northernmost islands by the evening
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by later afternoon through evening hours.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Mostly cloudy to occasionally overcast.**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Central Bahamas: 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.**WINDS:** **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, occasionally falling to 10 knots or less.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy during the early hours, with gradual clearing by the evening hours Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy Central and Southeast Bahamas: Cloudy to overcast.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms, decreasing to 20% by the evening hours Elsewhere: 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, shifting east to southeast at 10 knots or less by the evening hours. Northwest Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 knots or less ahead of the trough, shifting east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots behind the trough. Central Bahamas: Light and variable, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots

WINDS:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots.
