



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A Heat Advisory remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands). The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Dust Advisory is now in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands. **Moderate** Saharan dust concentrations are affecting the aforementioned areas, reducing visibility and impacting air quality. Residents, especially those with respiratory conditions, should take the necessary precautions to safeguard their health.

Very warm and hazy conditions will continue across the archipelago supported by a dominant ridge of high pressure and a moderate intrusion of Saharan dust. Meanwhile, a few quick, passing showers are possible this afternoon during peak daytime heating hours.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: A secondary plume of Saharan dust and broad ridging will dominate all areas through to midweek. These features will act to suppress rainfall and convective activity while maintaining very warm temperatures. By Thursday, increasing troughing over the northern islands is expected to raise shower and thunderstorm chances once again heading into the weekend.

Rip Currents: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of rip currents along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the archipelago. **Beachgoers, especially those in the Central & Southeast Bahamas, are urged to exercise caution.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 - 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.
WINDS: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 102°F – 106°F / 39°C – 41°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly sunny and a bit hazy this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 - 20% chance of an afternoon shower or two.
WINDS: Southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny and a bit hazy this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 - 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: East-southeast at 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):**

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly sunny and a bit hazy this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.

WINDS: East to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.***EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 24TH JUNE, 2026:**

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, becoming partly cloudy at night.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the Southeastern islands.

Elsewhere: Partly sunny and hazy.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 20 to 30% showers and isolated thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 10 to 30% chance of showers or isolated thunderstorm

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast 15 to 20 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 84°F – 92°F / 29°C – 33°C 73°F – 81°F / 23°C – 27°C 96°F – 104°F / 36°C – 40°C

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast 15 to 20 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 96°F – 104°F / 36°C – 40°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 27TH JUNE, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds.
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: **All Areas:** 10 to 30% chance of showers with the chance of isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C



EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 28TH JUNE, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: All Areas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning fair to partly cloudy at night.

PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 to 30% chance of showers with the chance of isolated thunderstorms.
 Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 86°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

 Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

WINDS: Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
