



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, TUESDAY, JUNE 30, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A tropical wave interacting with a surface trough east of the Southeastern islands will cast a few isolated showers or thunderstorms over portions of that area this afternoon as the system moves westward. Additionally, moisture and troughing ahead of a sagging frontal boundary to our north will support increasingly unstable conditions over portions of the Northern Bahamas later this evening through the overnight hours. Elsewhere, weak high pressure will remain the dominant weather feature, maintaining light to moderate breezes, relatively hot, humid conditions and a few possible stray showers during peak heating hours.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The combined effects of the front and a westward bound tropical wave moving south of the area will cultivate a relatively wet and unstable weather pattern that will persist through the weekend. Slightly drier and windy conditions are anticipated across portions of the Central and Southeast Bahamas, as a plume of Saharan dust follows the wave. By the beginning of next week, expect more widespread showers and thunderstorms as another tropical wave along with an upper-level disturbance moves into the region.

Rip Currents: A *slight* to *moderate* risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines of the island chain. **Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Heat/UV Index: Members of the public are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as **UV indices** are expected to be in the *very high to extreme* range, and the **heat index** possibly reaching the *triple digits* across all areas.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, turning partly cloudy to cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of isolated showers with possible isolated thunderstorms this afternoon, increasing to a 40 – 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms late evening through tonight. *Some showers and thunderstorms may become strong to severe at times.*
WINDS: Variable at 10 knots or less.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 77°F / 23°C – 25°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of isolated afternoon showers or thunderstorms, **mainly over Andros.**
WINDS: Northeast to east 10 knots or less, falling light and variable.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 77°F / 23°C – 25°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny to sunny this afternoon, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS****(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):**

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy with occasional cloudy periods over the Turks and Caicos Islands this afternoon through this evening.
Expect a mix of sun and clouds elsewhere, turning partly cloudy tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 30 – 50% chance of isolated to widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms across the *Turks and Caicos Islands and Mayaguana* this afternoon through this evening.
10 – 30% chance of showers or thunderstorms elsewhere.

WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

**TROPICAL WEATHER
OUTLOOK:**

There is one (1) area of interest offshore of the southeastern US Coast: A weak area of low pressure located along a frontal boundary off the southeastern U.S. coast is associated with limited shower and thunderstorm activity has a **10 percent chance of tropical cyclone formation** during the next 48 hours and the next seven (7) days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 1ST JULY, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy and a bit hazy.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning fair to partly cloudy at night.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 30 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Variable at 10 knots or less.
Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C 96°F – 100°F / 36°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 2ND JULY, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy at first, with gradual clearing and hazy conditions by the evening hours.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms early in the day.

WINDS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 knots or less, shifting east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C 73°F – 79°F / 23°C – 26°C 95°F – 100°F / 35°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 3RD JULY, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds and hazy, turning mostly fair tonight.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots. Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C	MINIMUM: 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C	HEAT INDEX: 95°F – 100°F / 35°C – 38°C

WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
