BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:	High pressure currently dominates weather conditions across the country, contributing to ample sunshine and gentle to fresh breezes. While daytime heating and available moisture may still trigger isolated showers or thunderstorms this afternoon, the chance for showers will increase later tonight into tomorrow, especially over the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas. **Outlook:** Into Wednesday, expect a shift to a more unsettled weather pattern, particularly across the Northern and Northwestern Bahamas. Increasing tropical moisture combined with upper-level disturbances will bring periods of clouds along with scattered showers and thunderstorms through the end of the workweek. Later in the week, the Southeastern Islands can also expect an uptick in showers and thunderstorms as a tropical wave and a mid- to upper-level low move into the region.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<i>Heat/UV Index:</i> Residents are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen, and to seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours, as a result of heat indices reaching in the upper 90's to lower triple digits, and UV levels in the very high to high range.

Two areas are currently being monitored:
1. Central Tropical Atlantic (AL92): A large area of showers and thunderstorms continues to show signs of organization midway between the Windward Islands and the coast of west Africa. Environmental conditions are conducive for further development, and a tropical depression or storm is likely to form in the next day or two. Formation chance through 2 days...high...90 percent.
2. Eastern Tropical Atlantic: A tropical wave emerging off the west coast of Africa is producing an area of disorganized showers and thunderstorms. Some slow development of this system is possible towards the mid to latter part of this week. Formation chance through 7 days...low...20 percent.
