BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

Generally cloudy conditions will persist across the country, with occasional periods of sunshine, as multi-layered troughing and abundant tropical moisture remain over the region. Shower and thunderstorm activity is expected to increase this evening across the northern half of the country as low-level troughing develops. Winds will remain light to gentle due to the prevailing weak pressure pattern.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: This moist and unstable airmass is expected to persist across the islands through the end of the week, producing showers and thunderstorms mainly across the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, while the Southeast Bahamas can expect occasional showers. Late Thursday, a cold front is forecast to enter the Northern Bahamas and gradually move southeastward, where it is expected to stall. A drier and more stable airmass will then filter into the northern islands by the weekend.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a moderate to high risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas beginning late this afternoon through the evening hours.* These storms could produce strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

Flooding: There is a slight to moderate risk of flooding in low-lying and flood-prone areas during heavy and prolonged rainfall events.

Rip Currents: There is a slight risk of rip currents impacting the eastern and southern shorelines of the Southeast Bahamas. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

Tropical Depression Fay, located 31.1N 34.6W or 645 miles southwest of the Azores. Maximum sustained winds are now near **35 mph** and the system is moving southwest at 10 mph. Fay is likely to degenerate into a post-tropical remnant low today.

Far Eastern Tropical Atlantic:
A tropical wave that is forecast to move off of the western African coast tomorrow. *The system has a low 30 percent chance of development through the next 7 days.*

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms. *Some showers may become heavy and thunderstorms strong to severe at times.*
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 - 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Light and variable at 10 knots or less.
Southeast Bahamas: Southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
