BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:	The country remains under the influence of a high pressure ridge which continues to produce moderate to occasionally strong breezes and generally stable weather conditions. Meanwhile, a surge of moisture moving in from the Atlantic will enhance shower activity, primarily over the Central & Southeast Bahamas, beginning late afternoon into tonight. Outlook: A relatively dry spell is expected to continue through Thursday, as high pressure remains the dominant weather feature. Winds are forecast to strengthen by late Thursday in response to an induced trough developing over the Lesser Antilles. This system will gradually move toward the Bahamas, reaching the southern islands by the weekend, where it will interact with an upper-level disturbance approaching from the eastern Gulf of Mexico. This interaction is expected to increase cloud cover and raise the likelihood of showers and thunderstorms beginning Friday and continuing into early next week. Another frontal system may enter the forecast area late Monday night into early Tuesday morning.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Coastal Flooding and Over-topping Waves: There is a moderate to high risk of overtopping waves along seawalls and coastal roads along Atlantic-exposed shorelines . A marginal risk of coastal flooding remains across all other northern and eastern-facing coastal roadways, mainly in the Central and Southeast Bahamas especially during high tide. Motorists and residents are urged to exercise extreme caution while traversing these areas. Rip Currents and Rough Surf: A high risk of dangerous, life-threatening rip currents and rough surf remains along all Atlantic-exposed beaches and area waters of the Central and Southeast Bahamas , while a moderate risk exists over the sheltered northern territorial waters . Beachgoers and swimmers should avoid entering the water in the Central and Southeast Bahamas, and along all northern, eastern and Atlantic-exposed shorelines.

SKY CONDITIONS:	A mix of sun and clouds this afternoon, turning partly cloudy late tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 - 20% chance of a quick passing shower or two this afternoon, increasing to a 20 – 30% of a few isolated showers by late evening into tonight.		
WINDS:	East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots today, increasing to 15 knots with higher gusts tonight.

PRECIPITATION:	10% chance of a quick passing shower or two this afternoon, increasing to a 30 – 40% of a few isolated showers by late evening into tonight.		
WINDS:	Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts today, increasing 15 to 20 knots tonight with higher gusts tonight.

PRECIPITATION:	10% chance of a quick passing shower or two this afternoon, increasing to a 30 – 40% of a few isolated showers by late evening into tonight.		
WINDS:	East-northeast to east at 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing 15 to 25 knots with occasional gusts to near gale possible tonight.

PRECIPITATION:	30 – 40% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, increasing 20 to 25 knots by late evening with gusts to near gale.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: Partly sunny with one or two cloudy intervals, turning partly cloudy at night. Central & Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern & Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of a few isolated showers. Central & Southeast Bahamas: 30% chance of widely scattered showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, increasing 15 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale by the nighttime hours. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale , increasing 20 to 25 knots by the evening.

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots with possible gusts to near gale . Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale .

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers, increasing up to 30% by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 40 – 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	All areas: Easterly at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale .

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair at night. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, decreasing to 15 knots by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale , decreasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 6 TH APRIL 2026:			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning partly cloudy at night. Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy with gradual clearing throughout the day.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers, increasing up to a 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms by nightfall. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 10 – 30% by nightfall.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to fall light and variable by nightfall. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 to 20 knots at first, veering southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to fall light and variable by nightfall.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy to cloudy at night. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less during the morning. West-southwest to west-northwest at 10 knots or less, climbing to 10 to 15 knots ahead of the front. Expect winds to veer north to northeast at 20 to 30 knots with gusts to gale force . Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, veering west to northwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
