BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2024. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:	A ridge of high pressure across the Bahamas will shift eastwards today ahead of an approaching prefrontal trough and a strong cold front presently in the eastern Gulf of Mexico. The approaching system will move into the Northern Bahamas tonight and push through the chain of islands Thursday before stalling across the Southeast Bahamas by Friday.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Beachgoers and swimmers in the Southeast Bahamas should continue to remain vigilant due to the slight risk of rip currents along east coast beaches and along Atlantic exposures.
