BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING EFFECT:

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A **Heat Advisory** remains in effect for the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas (inclusive of the islands of Grand Bahama, Bimini, Abaco and The Berry Islands). **The public should remain hydrated, limit strenuous outdoor activities and seek shaded areas during peak heat hours.**

Troughing ahead of a sagging frontal boundary near North Florida is supporting the development of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms across portions of the northernmost islands and cays of the Bahamas. This area of troughing is expected to gradually weaken throughout the day with shower and thunderstorm activity decreasing by late afternoon/early evening. Elsewhere, generally stable weather conditions will persist courtesy of a dominant ridge of high pressure.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Settled weather conditions are expected to continue through Thursday, as moisture gradually lifts northward. Another plume of Saharan dust embedded within a strengthening high pressure system will become established across the region heading into the weekend. By late Monday, the combined influence of an upper-level low and an approaching frontal boundary may increase cloud cover and modestly enhance the potential for showers and thunderstorms across portions of the Bahamas.

Rip Currents: There is a **slight to moderate risk** of rip currents for the Atlantic and east to southeastern coastlines of the Southeast Bahamas. **Beachgoers are urged to continue to exercise caution.**

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a **slight to moderate** risk of a few severe thunderstorms that may impact portions of the **Northern Bahamas** this afternoon, particularly over Northern Cays. Residents are urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high to extreme** range.

**NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):**

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably cloudy this afternoon, turning partly cloudy tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 30 – 40% chance of isolated to widely scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms this afternoon, decreasing to a 10 – 20% chance of showers by early evening.

WINDS: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION: 10 – 20% chance of a stray shower or two.

WINDS: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: Mostly sunny, turning fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, increasing 15 to 25 knots by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 10 – 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 15 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts by nightfall.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 98°F – 106°F / 37°C – 41°C

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing to 15 knots by nightfall.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

WINDS: Central and Southeast Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
