



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, Wednesday, June 3, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

A **Severe Weather Watch** is in effect for the Islands and adjacent waters of the **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas** through tonight. Residents in the warning areas should remain updated on all Severe Weather Warnings for the above mentioned areas.

Dust Advisory: A **Saharan Dust Advisory** is now in effect for the **Central & Southeast Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands**. Air Quality Index (AQI) will be **Moderate** to **Unhealthy** for Sensitive Groups, and visibility may be significantly reduced in some areas. *People with respiratory or heart disease, the elderly and children should limit prolonged exposure by remaining indoors and wearing masks during this event.*

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A deep layered trough associated with a stationary front across the Northern Bahamas and streaming moisture from a trough in the Gulf of Mexico is maintaining a moist unstable airmass across the country. Hazy skies, due to Saharan Dust, will inhibit shower and thunderstorm activity within the Central and Southeast islands.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The frontal boundary and its associated moisture will slowly advance southwards on Thursday, leading to an uptick in shower and thunderstorm activity across the Central Islands. The front is expected to linger over the area through Friday, maintaining an elevated chance for showers and thunderstorms, particularly across the Central & Southeast Bahamas and portions of the Northwest Bahamas.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a **high** risk of dangerous, **life-threatening** rip currents across the **Northern Bahamas**, especially along north and east coast beaches. **Beachgoers are strongly discouraged from entering the water at this time.**

A **slight** risk of rip currents exists elsewhere along all Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain. Beachgoers should exercise caution when entering the water.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy to overcast through tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 50 to 80% chance of scattered showers and widely scattered thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northeast at 15 to 20 knots.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy to overcast through tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 40 to 60% chance of scattered showers and Isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 82°F – 86°F / 28°C – 30°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 81°F / 25°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy through tonight.

PRECIPITATION: 40 to 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 86°F – 90°F / 30°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

**SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS**

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy through tonight.**PRECIPITATION:** 20 to 30 % chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms**WINDS:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots falling light and variable at times.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 5TH JUNE 2026.**SKY CONDITIONS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Mix of sun and clouds at first, becoming partly sunny by afternoon and mostly fair at night.**Northwest & Central Bahamas:** Mostly cloudy.**Southeast Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy.**Northern & Southeast Bahamas:** 10 - 20% chance of showers or thunderstorms.**PRECIPITATION:** **Northwest & Central Bahamas:** 30 – 40% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.**WINDS:** **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.**Southeast Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 6TH JUNE 2026.**SKY CONDITIONS:** **Northern Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy during the early hours, with gradual clearing by the evening hours**Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy**Central and Southeast Bahamas:** Cloudy to overcast.**PRECIPITATION:** **Northern Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms, decreasing to 20% by the evening hours**Elsewhere:** 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms.**Northern Bahamas:** Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, shifting east to southeast at 10 knots or less by the evening hours.**WINDS:** **Northwest Bahamas:** Northeast to east at 10 knots or less ahead of the trough, shifting east to southeast at 10 to 15 knots behind the trough.**Central Bahamas:** Light and variable, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours**Southeast Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots
