BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON, –NIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, WEDNESDAY, JULY 1, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

GENERAL SITUATION:

A remnant trough is sitting across the Northern Bahamas supporting showers and thunderstorms over the area. Meanwhile a surface trough weakening over the Southeast Bahamas is embedded in Saharan Dust which is suppressing shower activity over the area. Hot and humid conditions with light to moderate winds, smooth seas and a few passing showers or a thunderstorm is occurring throughout the country while high pressure cover the islands.

Outlook: Persistent troughing across the Northern Islands will maintain elevated shower and thunderstorm chances in the northwestern Bahamas through Friday, while the Saharan dust plume suppresses convection across the Central and Southeast regions. By late Friday, another tropical wave and upper-level disturbance will approach from the east, setting the stage for more widespread showers and thunderstorms by the weekend while high pressure strengthens over the archipelago.

Rip Currents: A slight to moderate risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed coastlines tonight and through the next six days. Beachgoers are urged to exercise caution when entering the water.

Heat/UV Index: **Very high to extreme UV indices** expected daily (11am–4pm) through the forecast period. Heat indices will reach triple digits across all areas today and tomorrow, moderating slightly by the weekend. Public is advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing and sunscreen, and seek shaded areas.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Saharan Dust: A plume of Saharan dust will bring hazy conditions and reduced visibility to the Central and Southeast Bahamas through Friday. People with respiratory ailments should take precautions.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy at first, with gradual clearing and hazy conditions by the evening hours.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms early in the day.
WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East-southeast to south-southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds and hazy, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

 Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
 Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

 Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
 Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.

 Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots gusting at times in the Southeast Bahamas.
