## **BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST**

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 12:00 P.M. EDT, WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	There remains a <i>marginal threat</i> of isolated strong to possibly severe thunderstorms particularly across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas this afternoon through tonight. These storms have the potential to produce strong gusty winds, heavy downpours, frequent lightning, and possible waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Therefore, a severe weather watch is in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas through tonight.
GENERAL SITUATION:	A mid to upper level disturbance continues to interact with tropical moisture producing bouts of showers and thunderstorms across the archipelagic chain through tonight.  Outlook: Lingering moisture coupled with troughing will continue to generate shower and thunderstorm activity over the Northern, Northwest and portions of the Central Bahamas. Meanwhile, a tropical wave is expected to move over the Southeast Bahamas before the weekend. Expect increased shower and rain activity across the island chain for the remainder of the week into the weekend.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Flooding: There is an elevated chance of flooding in low lying or flood prone areas during heavy showers or prolonged rainfall events. Therefore, residents are urged to exercise caution.  Heat/UV Index: Residents in the Central and Southeast Bahamas are advised to remain hydrated, wear protective clothing, such as wide-brimmed hats, sunglasses, and sunscreen, and to seek shaded areas during peak daylight hours, as a result of heat indices reaching in the upper 90's to lower triple digits, and UV levels in the high to very high range.
