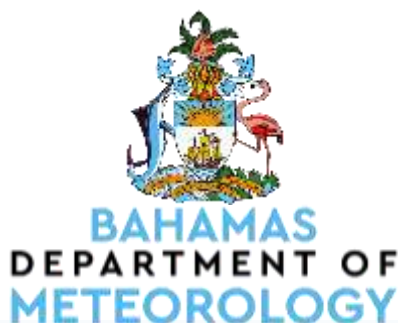

NEWS ITEM ON THE **REMNANTS OF DOLLY** ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY, FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, ON **Friday, August 28, 2026 AT 12PM.**

***...DOLLY IS NOW AN OPEN TROPICAL WAVE...
...INTERESTS IN THE LEEWARD ISLANDS SHOULD MONITOR THE
PROGRESS OF THE REMNANTS...***

AT 11AM EDT (1500 UTC), THE REMNANTS OF DOLLY WERE LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 15.0 NORTH, LONGITUDE 46.9 WEST. THE REMNANTS ARE MOVING TOWARD THE WEST NEAR 25 MPH (41 KM/H) AND THIS MOTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE FOR THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS.

ON THE FORECAST TRACK, THE REMNANTS SHOULD BE NEARING THE LEEWARD ISLANDS SATURDAY NIGHT AND SUNDAY.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 40 MPH (65 KM/H) WITH HIGHER GUSTS. THE WINDS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REMNANTS OF DOLLY ARE EXPECTED TO DECREASE BELOW TROPICAL-STORM FORCE ON SATURDAY.
