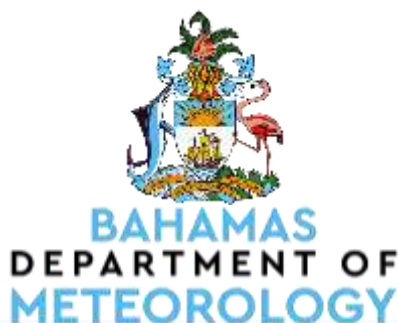

NEWS ITEM

NEWS ITEM ON **TROPICAL STORM FAY**, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY, FORECAST OFFICE SECTION, ON **Monday, September 21, 2026** AT 12:00 PM EDT.

...FAY MOVING SLOWLY SOUTHWARD...

AT 11 PM EDT, THE CENTER OF **TROPICAL STORM FAY** WAS LOCATED NEAR **LATITUDE 33.3° NORTH** AND **LONGITUDE 32.0° WEST**, OR ABOUT **430 MILES SOUTHWEST** OF THE AZORES.

FAY IS MOVING TOWARD THE **SOUTH** NEAR **5 MPH**. A GRADUAL TURN TOWARD THE SOUTHWEST AND WEST-SOUTHWEST IS EXPECTED OVER THE NEXT FEW DAYS.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS HAVE DECREASED TO NEAR **50 MPH** (85 KM/H) WITH HIGHER GUSTS. CONTINUED WEAKENING IS FORECAST, AND **FAY** COULD DEGENERATE TO A POST-TROPICAL REMNANT LOW IN A COUPLE OF DAYS.

THIS SYSTEM POSES NO THREAT TO THE BAHAMAS.
