SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning valid from 2:15 PM to 3:15 PM, Wednesday 24th June 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning is NOW in effect for West Grand Bahama and Bimini.

The Severe Thunderstorm Warning for North Abaco and its cays has been discontinued.

The Severe Weather Warning for Central & East Grand Bahama has also been discontinued.

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch remains in effect for the Northern Bahamas.

At 2:00 pm, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted large clusters of moderate to heavy showers and embedded thunderstorms moving toward the warning and watch areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with low-level troughing combined with rich tropical moisture ahead of a sagging frontal boundary near North/Central Florida.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning areas should seek safe harbor and residents should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.
