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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING UPDATE

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has UPDATED a Severe Thunderstorm Warning valid from 2:30 pm to 3:40 pm, Friday 24th July 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning is now in effect for Andros along with their adjacent waters and cats

The Severe Thunderstorm Warning has been discontinued for North and Central Abaco, south Long Island AND for eastern New Providence.

At 2:28 pm, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted clusters of moderate to heavy showers and embedded thunderstorms slowly drifting moving northwestward towards and across the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are in relation to troughing associated with a deep layered disturbance to the west and moisture streaming across the area.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning area should seek safe harbour, and all other mariners should avoid the area.
