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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has re-issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning valid from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM, Friday 5th June 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning remains in effect for Inagua along with its adjacent waters and cays.

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is in effect for Mayaguana and its adjacent waters.

At 3:01 pm, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery depicted a cluster of moderate to heavy showers and thunderstorms moving across and towards the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with an active frontal boundary near the Central Bahamas being aided by a mid to upper-level trough.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning areas should seek safe harbor and residents should stay indoors and away from windows when conditions worsen. Residents should not seek shelter under trees or in water as these can become lightning conductors.
