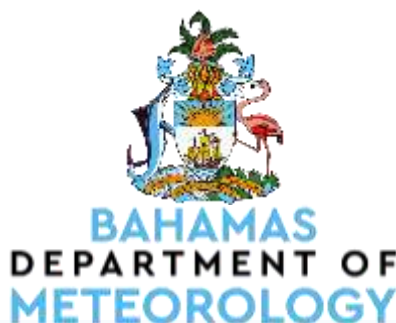

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING



THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS RE-ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING UPDATE ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 21, 2026 FROM 3:20 PM EDT UNTIL 5:20 PM EDT.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO FROM MARSH HARBOUR TO NORTHERN PART OF THE ISLAND, MOORE'S ISLAND ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS AND CAYS.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS WARNING IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR CENTRAL AND SOUTH ELEUTHERA, ANDROS,

AT 3:15 PM EDT OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY CONTINUED TO DEPICT CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS AND EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS MOVING NORTHWARDS TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREA. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH TROUING AND ITS ASSOCIATED MOISTURE.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
