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SEVERE WEATHER WARNING AND WATCH UPDATE

The Bahamas Department of Meteorology has issued a Severe Thunderstorm Warning and Watch valid from 3:40 pm to 5:00 pm, Friday 31st July 2026.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning remains in effect for Central Grand Bahama, South Abaco, Northern, Southern Andros and Central Eleuthera along with their adjacent waters and cays. The warning NOW includes North Eleuthera along with their adjacent waters.

A Severe Weather Watch remains in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas along with their adjacent waters and cays.

At 3:35 pm, lightning detection, observation, radar, and satellite imagery continued to depict clusters of moderate to heavy showers and embedded thunderstorms moving towards and across the warning areas. These showers and thunderstorms are associated with lingering troughing and tropical moisture.

Some of these showers will be locally heavy and thunderstorms will be strong and severe at times causing strong gusty winds, dangerous lightning, heavy downpours, possible hail, waterspout and/or tornadic activity. Localized flooding is also possible during these storms.

Boaters in the warning area should seek safe harbour, and all other mariners should avoid the area.
