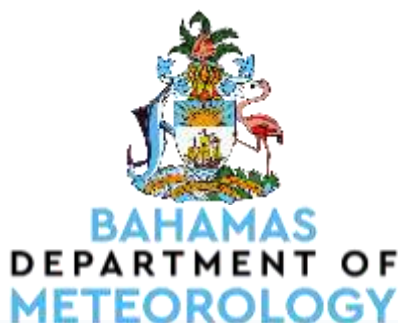

SEVERE WEATHER WARNING



THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2026 ON 4:53 AM EDT UNTIL 6:00 AM EDT.

A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR RAGGED ISLAND, ALONG WITH THEIR ADJACENT WATERS.

AT 4:53 AM EDT OBSERVATION, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY SHOWED CLUSTERS OF INTENSE THUNDERSTORMS MOVING WESTWARDS TOWARDS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE REMNANTS OF DOLLY.

SOME OF THESE THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREA SHOULD STAY INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
