BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST, Saturday, February 14, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

	<p>A Near Gale Warning (28–33 knots) is in effect for the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Occasional gusts to near-gale force are likely across those areas beginning at 12 am until about 12 noon on Sunday. Boaters, especially small craft, are urged to seek safe shelter and remain in port.</p>
WARNING IN EFFECT:	<p>A Near Gale Watch (28–33 knots) is in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. Occasional gusts to near-gale force are possible across those areas beginning at 12 pm Sunday to 12 pm Monday. GENERAL SITUATION:	<p>High pressure continues to build across the islands producing moderate to fresh breezes. Mostly stable weather conditions are expected for Sunday with the chance of an isolated passing shower or two due to lingering moisture.</p> <p>Outlook: A cold front, accompanied by scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms, is expected to enter the Northern islands on Monday. The front will quickly move through the island chain and reach the Southeastern islands by Tuesday. High pressure will build across the archipelago by mid-week, contributing once again to more stable weather conditions.</p>
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	<p>Rip Currents: A moderate to high risk of dangerous, life-threatening rip currents exists along all exposed shorelines of the island chain. Beachgoers and swimmers should avoid entering the water in these areas.</p>

WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest, shifting west to northwest at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale force. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to south at 15 knots, shifting west to northwest by nightfall.
