BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT, TOMORROW AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Tuesday, October 28, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	A HURRICANE WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR THE CENTRAL AND SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS. GENERAL SITUATION:	A trough across the Northern islands along with streaming moisture from the outer bands of Hurricane Melissa will support showers and thunderstorm activity across the island chain. However, Hurricane Melissa is expected to move across the Central and Southeastern islands beginning early Wednesday through Thursday morning producing hurricane and tropical storm conditions including widespread showers and thunderstorms, very strong winds along with dangerous seas Outlook: Hurricane Melissa is forecasted to exit the island chain on Thursday with a gradual improvement in weather conditions as the day progresses. However, hazardous marine conditions will persist through the end of the week. A cold front is forecast to move into the Northern and Northwest Bahamas heading into the weekend, leading to increased showers across those areas ahead of the front, followed by a transition to drier, more stable and cooler conditions behind it.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Rip Currents: Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to refrain from entering the waters due to hazardous rip currents and rough surf along north and east-coast facing shorelines throughout The Bahamas.
