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## SEVERE WEATHER WARNING

THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY HAS ISSUED A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING FROM 6:30 AM EDT UNTIL 8:00 AM EDT, MONDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025.

***A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS IN EFFECT FOR CENTRAL ANDROS, THE NORTHERN EXUMA CAYS (FROM SHIP CHANNEL CAY TO NORMAN'S CAY) AND THEIR ADJACENT WATERS.***

AT 6:25 AM EDT, OBSERVATIONS, RADAR AND SATELLITE IMAGERY DISPLAYED CLUSTERS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY SHOWERS WITH EMBEDDED THUNDERSTORMS THAT ARE MOVING TOWARDS AND ACROSS THE WARNING AREAS. THESE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE ASSOCIATED WITH TROUGHING AND MOISTURE.

SOME OF THESE SHOWERS WILL BE HEAVY AND THUNDERSTORMS SEVERE AT TIMES CAUSING STRONG GUSTY WINDS, DANGEROUS LIGHTNING, HEAVY DOWNPOURS, HAIL AND POSSIBLE WATERSPOUT OR TORNADIC ACTIVITY. LOCALIZED FLOODING IS ALSO POSSIBLE DURING THE PASSAGE OF THESE STORMS.

BOATERS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD IMMEDIATELY SEEK SAFE HARBOUR AND RESIDENTS IN THE WARNING AREAS SHOULD REMAIN INDOORS AND AWAY FROM WINDOWS WHEN CONDITIONS WORSEN. RESIDENTS SHOULD NOT SEEK SHELTER UNDER TREES OR IN WATER AS THESE CAN BECOME LIGHTNING CONDUCTORS.
