



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Monday, June 22, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNINGS:	<p>There is a moderate risk of rip currents for the Atlantic and southeastern coastlines of the Southeast Bahamas.</p> <p>Marine Heat Advisory: Mariners are advised that high heat indices (above 105°F/40.5°C) are expected across the waters of The Bahamas. Prolonged exposure to the sun and hot conditions may increase the risk of heat-related illnesses. Stay hydrated, limit strenuous activity, seek shade when possible, and monitor crew members for signs of heat stress.</p>
GENERAL SITUATION:	Moderate to locally fresh winds along with slight to moderate seas will affect the Islands of The Bahamas through the next few days. Meanwhile an encroaching layer of Saharan dust will reduce visibility and air quality. Persons with respiratory sensitivities should take the necessary precautions.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:	<i>Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in or near showers or thunderstorms.</i>
WINDS:	Southerly at 10 knots or less.
LOCAL SEAS:	1 to 3 feet.
GULF STREAM:	1 feet.
SWELLS:	No significant swells.
WEATHER:	20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:	<i>Gusty winds, higher seas and reduced visibility can be experienced in or near showers or thunderstorms.</i>
WINDS:	Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots.
LOCAL SEAS:	1 to 3 feet.
SWELLS:	No significant swells.
WEATHER:	10 to 20% chance of showers.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS (INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:	<i>Small craft operators should exercise caution. Visibility reduced in moderate haze.</i>
WINDS:	East to southeast at 15 knots with higher gusts.
LOCAL SEAS:	2 to 4 feet nearshore and offshore local waters but up to 5 feet along Atlantic exposures.
SWELLS:	Slight easterly and southeasterly swells.
WEATHER:	10% chance of showers.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:	<i>A small craft advisory along Atlantic exposures but a small craft caution in effect for local waters. Visibility reduced in moderate haze.</i>
WINDS:	East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots.
LOCAL SEAS:	4 to 6 feet in nearshore and local offshore waters but up to 7 feet along Atlantic exposures.
SWELLS:	Slight easterly and southeasterly swells.
WEATHER:	10% chance of showers.

ADVISORY:	A small craft advisory will be in effect for Atlantic waters in the Southeastern Islands while a caution will be in effect for the remainder of the area. A small craft caution will be in effect for Atlantic water in Central Bahamas .
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Southerly at 10 knots or less. Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the Southeastern islands.
SEAS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 2 to 4 feet. Central Bahamas: 2 to 4 feet nearshore and offshore local waters but up to 5 feet along Atlantic exposures Southeast Bahamas: 4 to 6 feet in nearshore and local offshore waters but up to 7 feet along Atlantic exposures.
WEATHER:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Isolated showers with the chance for a few isolated thunderstorms. Elsewhere: No significant weather.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 24TH JUNE, 2026:

ADVISORY:	A small craft advisory will be in effect for Atlantic waters in the Southeastern Islands while a caution will be in effect for the remainder of the area. A small craft caution will be in effect for Atlantic water in Central Bahamas .
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less. Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times. Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the Southeastern islands.
SEAS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 2 to 4 feet. Central Bahamas: 2 to 4 feet nearshore and offshore local waters but up to 5 feet along Atlantic exposures Southeast Bahamas: 4 to 6 feet in nearshore and local offshore waters but up to 7 feet along Atlantic exposures.
WEATHER:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Isolated showers with the chance for a few isolated thunderstorms. Central and Southeast Bahamas: No significant weather.
