

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EST, Monday, October 6, 2025, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EST.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	Hazardous marine conditions continue in Atlantic-exposed waters. Large to moderate swells, high surf, dangerous rip currents, and rough seas are expected to impact northern and eastern shorelines through the middle of the week. Beach goers and swimmers are urged not to venture into the waters and mariners/boaters are strongly urged NOT to venture into Atlantic-exposed waters. Coastal Risks: Motorists and road users across all areas are urged to exercise

GENERAL SITUATION:	A stalled front will continue to support cloudiness with showers and thunderstorms across portions of the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas. Moderate to fresh breezes will prevail behind the front while light to gentle breezes flow ahead of the front. Outlook: The large scale pattern is expected to remain the same with an abundance or tropical moisture sparking daily isolated showers and thunderstorms; then a cold front will move into the Northern Bahamas late this week.

Central Tropical Atlantic (AL95)

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

A broad area of low pressure associated with a low-latitude tropical wave continues to produce a large area of disorganized cloudiness and showers several hundred miles southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands. Environmental conditions appear conducive for gradual development, and a tropical depression is likely to form midweek as it moves quickly across the central tropical Atlantic. This system has a high or 70% chance of tropical cyclone formation during the next seven (7) days.
