



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Monday, September 7, 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT: A **Severe Weather Watch** is in effect for the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. For marine forecasts and our other products please see our webpage: met.gov.bs

Rich tropical moisture will continue to fuel elevated shower and thunderstorm chances across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas today, as troughing associated with a frontal boundary over the Southeast U.S persist across the area. Across the Southeast Bahamas, a nearby tropical wave may also enhance shower and thunderstorm activity through this afternoon as it continues to trek westward. Breezes are expected to remain gentle to moderate across the island chain.

GENERAL SITUATION: **Outlook:** The frontal boundary will continue to linger through early Tuesday, keeping abundant moisture across the region, maintaining unsettled weather conditions across the Northern and Northwestern islands. Conditions should gradually improve by Wednesday into early Thursday as the boundary lifts northward and the upper-level low shifts to the west, allowing ridging to rebuild across the country. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms still remain possible, as a summer-time weather pattern returns, and moisture continues to stream across the island chain. However, by Saturday, shower and thunderstorm chances once again are forecasted to increase when another frontal boundary dips into the Southeastern US, resulting in troughing across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, before merging with troughing associated with a wave across the Central Bahamas on Sunday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Flood Risk:** There is a **slight** risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the Northern Bahamas and Northwest Bahamas.

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **high** range.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly cloudy today through tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms
WINDS: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by the afternoon hours.
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 93°F / 31°C – 34°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly cloudy today, becoming variably cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 40 to 60% chance of showers with thunderstorms
WINDS: Southeast to south less than 10 knots, becoming light and variable by the afternoon hours.
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 93°F / 31°C – 34°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C



CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun and clouds today, becoming variably cloudy tonight
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms
WINDS: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by the afternoon hours
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** **MAXIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 89°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Variably to partly cloudy today, becoming mostly fair tonight
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of shower with thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less during the afternoon hours.
TEMPERATURES: **MINIMUM:** **MAXIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 88°F – 93°F / 31°C – 34°C 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: *Tropical cyclone activity is not expected during the next 7 days.*

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TUESDAY 8TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern Bahamas:** Cloudy to occasionally overcast.
Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly cloudy
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central Bahamas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at less than 10 knots, becoming variable during the afternoon hours, and easterly at 10 knots or less by the evening hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, occasional 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C 95°F – 100°F / 35°C – 38°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 9TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Southeast Bahamas:** A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
Elsewhere: Partly cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming 10 knots or less across the Northern Bahamas by the evening hours.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, increasing to 15 to 20 knots during the overnight hours.
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C



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EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All Areas: A mix of sun and clouds

PRECIPITATION: All areas: 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots during the morning hours, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the afternoon.
Northwest Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 11TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** South-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less during the day, becoming east to southeast at less than 10 knots by the evening.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.

PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming variable during the afternoon hours, and east to southeast at 10 knots or less during the evening hours
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Elsewhere: a mix of sun and clouds

PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible.
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts occurring across the Southeast Bahamas.
