



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Monday, August 10, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A Heat Advisory remains in effect for the entire Bahamas. Residents and visitors should take the necessary precautions while outdoors during peak sunshine hours (10 am – 4 pm) and to safeguard their health as heat indices ranging from 100°F to 108°F are anticipated.

Winds gentle to moderate in the North and Northwest and moderate to strong in the Central and Southeast Bahamas along with seas moderate to rough is across the country while a broad high pressure system sits over the area. Low level moisture will maintain quick passing showers mainly in the North and Northwest Islands, while a tropical wave is passing south of the Southeast Islands with little fanfare due to the presence of Saharan Dust in these islands.

GENERAL SITUATION:

OUTLOOK: The deep ridge of high pressure will dominate weather conditions across The Bahamas throughout the upcoming workweek, promoting hot temperatures and gentle to moderate winds. Rainfall chances will remain low as a dry air mass, along with a plume of Saharan dust, persists across the region, contributing to hazy or milky skies and slightly reduced air quality in some areas. By Thursday, the ridge is expected to retreat as a tropical wave moves into the Southeast Bahamas, increasing the potential for showers and thunderstorms as it interacts with an mid-level low. These features are forecast to migrate northwestward, bringing additional showers and thunderstorms across the central and northern islands before more stable conditions return across the country by the start of next weekend.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a moderate to high risk of rip currents for ALL Atlantic coastal waters of the Bahamas as well as east and southeast sheltered coastal waters across portions of the Central and the entire Southeast Bahamas.

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the very high to extreme range.

PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS			
(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly sunny and hazy today, fair tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm.		
WINDS:	Easterly at 20 to 25 knots with gust to near gale force at night.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 86°F – 91°F / 30°C – 33°C	MINIMUM: 77°F – 84°F / 25°C – 29°C	HEAT INDEX: 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:	Central Tropical Atlantic: A tropical wave located about midway between west Africa and the Lesser Antilles has a low 10 % chance of formation through 7 days as it moves westward across the Central Tropical Atlantic.
	Eastern and Central Tropical Atlantic: A tropical wave is forecasted to merge with an area of low pressure located a few hundred miles south of the Carbo Verde Islands. The system has a medium 60% chance of formation through the next 7 days as environmental conditions become more favorable by midweek.
	Western Subtropical Atlantic: A trough of low pressure located a few hundred miles northwest of Bermuda has a low 10% chance of formation while it moves eastward and into cooler waters later this week.
	<i>These systems poses no threat to the Bahamas at this time.</i>

PRECIPITATION:	All Areas: 10% chance of stray showers. Northern Bahamas: Southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable.		
WINDS:	Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots falling 10 knots or less at night. Central Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 20 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale force possible near the Inaguas.

PRECIPITATION:	All areas: 10 to 20% chance of showers. Northern Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less.		
WINDS:	Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less. Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots. Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots, a bit gusty at times.

Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.
Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots, with occasional gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 25 knots with *gusts to near gale force possible*.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots but gusty at times across the Northwest Bahamas.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots but gusty over the Southeastern Islands.
