

BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EST, Monday, December 22, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EST.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	A Wind Advisory is in effect for the Northern & Northwest Bahamas. Please see more information in our Marine Forecast at our website, met.gov.bs.
	Troughing associated with the remnants of a frontal boundary near the Central Bahamas will continue to support periods of shower activity over that area today through tonight. Elsewhere, conditions will remain mostly dry as another weak cold front approaches from the north. Meanwhile, strong high pressure building in behind the front will produce strong to near gale-force winds across much of the island chain through midweek.
GENERAL SITUATION:	<u>Outlook:</u> Dangerous beaching and boating conditions are expected to persist through the remainder of the week due to strong winds and lingering swell conditions. The aforementioned front will move into the southeast Bahamas late Tuesday into Wednesday, bringing a few showers to the area before exiting late Wednesday. Another weak reinforcing front, accompanied by a drier air mass, is forecast to move into the region during the Christmas and Boxing Day holidays with little impact, keeping rain chances very low through the latter part of the week.
	Rip Currents/Rough Surf: There is a high risk of hazardous rip currents and rough surf conditions impacting Atlantic shorelines. Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to refrain from entering the waters in these areas.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Wind Hazards: As a result of wind gusts possibly exceeding 35 miles per hour, residents across all areas are urged to secure or tie down relatively light loose objects in their yards, and to drive carefully, especially along roads along northern and eastern shorelines. Small craft operators are <u>strongly urged</u> to remain in port, while beachgoers and swimmers should abstain from entering into the waters.
	Coastal Hazards: There is a risk of minor coastal flooding and beach erosion along northern and eastern coastal areas. Large, overtopping waves and windblown sand is likely, and can prove hazardous to motorists and pedestrians. Therefore, it is advised that extreme caution is exercised while traversing these areas, especially the Glass Window Bridge in Eleuthera.
