



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Saturday, April 25, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>An upper-level trough moving eastwards across the area will continue to spark showers with occasional thunderstorms mainly across the Southeast Bahamas this morning. Expect gradually improvement in weather conditions, as this feature exits the Bahamas into the Atlantic by this afternoon. A weak pressure pattern will keep a light wind regime in place across the island chain through tonight, allowing for mostly tranquil conditions with occasional showers.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> Gentle breezes and lingering moisture will keep occasional pops of showers in the forecast, with a dry air mass capping any significant weather for the majority of the week ahead. A weak frontal boundary will drift and linger just north of the island chain by early Monday, crossing the Northernmost islands by Monday afternoon and exiting the area by midweek with little fanfare. High pressure will become nestled over the area by Wednesday, keeping the light wind regime in place. Another late season cold front may move off the Florida coast by the end of the week, bringing in possible thunderstorm activity beginning late Thursday.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Potential Thunderstorm Risk:</b> Thunderstorms in the <b>Southeast Bahamas</b> can become strong-to-severe at times. The public urged to keep updated of all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.</p> <p><b>Rip Currents:</b> There remains a marginal risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters of the island chain. There is a slight risk of rip currents on the sheltered waters of the island chain. Beachgoers in these areas are urged to exercise caution.</p>

<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mostly cloudy, with gradual clearing throughout the day. Expect partly cloudy conditions tonight.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 10 – 30% by late afternoon.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, shifting northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times by the afternoon hours.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<b>All areas:</b> 10 – 30% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.		
	<b>Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Easterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times, shifting north to northeast at 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to veer south-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less by nightfall.		
	<b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours, falling light and variable at times.
