



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EST, Saturday, November 15, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EST.

GENERAL SITUATION:	A dissipating boundary near the Southeast Bahamas will continue to support some shower activity into this evening. Meanwhile, a weak cold front is expected to move across the Northern portion of the country through this afternoon with some light spotty showers possible. Outlook: On Sunday, high pressure will become the dominant weather feature in conjunction with a dry air mass, supporting stable weather conditions across the country. Temperatures are also expected to rebound toward seasonal averages heading into the new work week as winds shift predominantly from the east. On Monday, another frontal boundary will skirt the Northern Islands, bringing the possibility of showers and an isolated thunderstorm through Tuesday.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	Rip Currents & Rough Surf: There is a high risk of rip currents and rough surf affecting coastlines of the Central and Southeast Bahamas. Beachgoers and swimmers in these areas are urged NOT to enter Atlantic waters and should exercise extreme caution when entering sheltered areas.
