



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Saturday, September 5, 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

Weak mid-level troughing just north of the archipelago, combined with persistent tropical moisture across the northern half of the country, will continue to support instability across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas today, increasing the likelihood of afternoon showers and thunderstorms. Meanwhile, surface troughing associated with a tropical wave just south of the area, interacting with an upper-level disturbance, may support isolated showers and thunderstorms across portions of the Southeast Bahamas.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Light to gentle breezes and smooth to slight seas are expected across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, while gentle to moderate breezes and slight to moderate seas will prevail across the Central and Southeast Bahamas.

Outlook: Moisture levels will increase across the country as the tropical wave continues to move westward, merging with existing moisture pooling just south of a frontal boundary across the southeastern United States through the weekend. As a result, weather conditions are expected to become increasingly active across the northern half of the country on Sunday. Expect a generally cloudy, wet, and humid pattern to persist through much of the week, as these features continue to influence the region.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: There is a slight to moderate risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas by late afternoon. These storms could produce strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.

Rip Currents: There is a slight risk of rip currents impacting the eastern and southern shorelines of the Bahamas. Beachgoers and swimmers are advised to exercise caution.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mix of sun and clouds today, becoming partly cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	30 - 40% chance of isolated to widely scattered showers or isolated thunderstorms, increasing to a 40 - 60% chance of showers and thunderstorms by late afternoon/early evening.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 knots tonight, falling light and variable on Saturday.

SKY CONDITIONS:	Mix of sun and clouds today, becoming partly cloudy tonight.		
PRECIPITATION:	20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms today, increasing to a 40 - 50% chance of showers and thunderstorms by late afternoon/early evening.		
WINDS:	East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mix of sun and clouds today, becoming partly cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30 % chance of isolated showers or thunderstorms.
WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds,
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon mainly across the Central Bahamas.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming easterly at 10 knots or less by the evening
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas by the afternoon
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts in the Southeast Bahamas.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: MAXIMUM: MINIMUM: HEAT INDEX:

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.
