



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Sunday, September 6, 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING EFFECT: IN *There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time.*

Periodic bouts of unsettled weather will remain possible across the northern half of the country, due to the effects of pre-frontal troughing and ample moisture pooling south of a front moving southwards and stalling across the Florida/ Georgia boundary. Elsewhere, weather associated with an approaching tropical wave will interact with an upper-level low centered across Hispaniola, enhancing shower activity while supporting short-lived isolated thunderstorms through tonight. A relatively light wind regime will keep humid and unstable conditions in place, as ridging across the area weakens.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: The front will remain quasi stationary for the first-half of the work week, as excessive moisture continues to accumulate across the region as the wave moves south of the area. As a result, cloudy, wet and humid conditions will prevail through to mid-week, as the upper-level low continues to influence the prevailing weather pattern. By late Wednesday, high pressure will rebound as the front shifts into the Atlantic, allowing for a more general summer pattern with slightly warmer temperatures and streaming showers from the Atlantic. On Saturday, expect higher shower and thunderstorm chances across the Northern Bahamas, as another front makes its way down across the southeastern US.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a slight to moderate* risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across all areas. These storms could produce **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**. **Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.**

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Cloudy to occasionally overcast today, becoming partly cloudy at night.
PRECIPITATION: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms today, decreasing 20 – 40% tonight.
WINDS: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy today, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: Variable at 10 knots or less.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 93°F / 31°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun and clouds today, turning mostly fair tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: Variable at 10 knots or less.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 89°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C
