



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Sunday, April 12, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<i>There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time. A <b>Near Gale Warning (28 – 33 knots)</b> remains in effect for the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas, while a <b>Near Gale Watch</b> remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas. <b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A tight pressure gradient between high pressure and a quasi-frontal boundary north of Hispaniola, continues to maintain moderate to fresh winds over The Bahamas. Meanwhile, outside of some showers anticipated across the southeastern islands, dry and mostly stable weather conditions will persist elsewhere.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> High pressure will continue to expand across the island chain, producing brisk breezes along with hazardous maritime conditions for the majority of next week, with conditions anticipated to improve by next weekend. Residual moisture along with low level troughing is expected to elevate shower activity over the southern islands over the next few days, while the remainder of the country will experience more dry and stable conditions.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Rip Currents and Rough Surf:</b> A <b>high risk</b> of dangerous, life-threatening rip currents and rough surf persists along all Atlantic-exposed beaches and passages of the island chain. <i>Beachgoers and swimmers are strongly advised to remain out of the water.</i></p> <p><b>On shore flooding:</b> There is a <b>moderate</b> risk of water inundation along all east-facing and Atlantic exposed shorelines across the island chain. <i>Mariners and pedestrians should exercise caution while traversing these areas, including the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera.</i></p>

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mostly fair tonight, turning mostly sunny on Sunday.

<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeasterly at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale, increasing 20 to 25 knots by evening hours.

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	A mix of sun and clouds during the morning becoming partly cloudy by afternoon hours into tonight.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	10% chance of showers, increasing 10 to 20% chance by afternoon hours.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeasterly at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale, increasing 20 to 25 knots by afternoon hours.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeasterly at 15 to 25 knots with gusts to near gale, increasing 20 to 25 knots by afternoon hours.

Elsewhere: Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with <i>possible gusts to near-gale force</i> .

Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with <i>possible gusts to near-gale force</i> mainly across the Southeast Bahamas.
