



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Sunday, August 16th 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

Heat Advisory: Heat advisory remains in effect for the entire Bahamas. Residents and visitors should take the necessary precautions while outdoors during peak sunshine hours (11 am – 4 pm) and to safeguard their health as heat indices ranging from 100°F to 108°F are anticipated.

A Dust Advisory remains in effect for the entire Bahamas, as well as the Turks & Caicos Islands through this evening. The level of dust is expected to reach moderate levels which may impact air quality and hinder visibility at times. Residents, especially those with respiratory illnesses, should take precautions to safeguard their health.

Near Gale Warning: A near gale warning (winds 28-33 knots) remains in effect for the Southeast Bahamas (Mainly south of Inagua) until 6pm. Residents should exercise extreme caution along Atlantic facing coastal roads due to wind driven waves that may cause overtopping waves and coastal flooding.

GENERAL SITUATION:

High pressure ridging and Saharan Dust will continue to dominate the region promoting quiet weather conditions today through tonight. Fresh to strong breezes with moderate to occasionally rough seas prevail across the Central and Southeast Bahamas, while gentle to moderate winds and slight to moderate seas continue across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas.

Outlook: Favorable marine conditions will spread into the southern half of the country as high pressure becomes centered over the Bahamas, contributing to light to gentle breezes and smooth to slight seas. Shower chances will also remain very low due to the presence of Saharan dust. By midweek, shower chances increase over the northern islands due to weak troughing and a slight uptick in moisture moving in from the north.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There is a **high** risk of rip currents for the Central and Southeast Bahamas while a **moderate** risk exists over the Northern and Northwest Bahamas. *Beachgoers and swimmers, particularly those in the Central and Southeast Bahamas, are strongly advised to refrain from entering waters along eastern and southern shorelines and Atlantic exposed beaches at this time.*

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the **very high** to **extreme** range today.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly sunny and hazy today, becoming fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.
WINDS: East-northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C 102°F – 108°F / 39°C – 42°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly to mostly sunny and hazy today, becoming fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: 10% chance of showers.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 – 20 knots with slightly higher gusts at times, shifting east-northeasterly by tonight.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C 77°F – 84°F / 25°C – 29°C 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly sunny and hazy today, becoming fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of an isolated shower or a thunderstorm.
WINDS: Easterly at 15 – 25 knots with **gusts to near gale force possible** through the early afternoon hours, shifting northeast to east by this evening while decreasing to 15 – 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 92°F / 30°C – 33°C 77°F – 84°F / 25°C – 29°C 100°F – 104°F / 38°C – 40°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 17TH AUGUST, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **All Areas:** Partly sunny and a bit hazy.
PRECIPITATION: **All Areas:** 10 to 20% chance of showers.
Northern Bahamas: Variable at less than 10 knots
Northwest Bahamas: East to Southeast at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable by the afternoon.
WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less by the evening hours
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots by the afternoon hours.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 95°F / 31°C – 35°C 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 98°F – 108°F / 36°C – 42°C

SKY CONDITIONS: **All Areas:** Partly sunny during the morning hours, becoming a mix of sun and clouds during the afternoon hours.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** 20% chance of showers
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable.
WINDS: **Central Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR WEDNESDAY 19TH AUGUST, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: All Areas: A mix of sun and clouds.

PRECIPITATION: Northern Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable across the Northwest Bahamas during the afternoon hours
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, gusty at times.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Expect a mix of sun and clouds.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny

PRECIPITATION: All Areas: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southerly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central Bahamas: Easterly at 10 knots or less, increasing to 10 to 15 knots by the evening
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts during the evening hours.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 96°F – 104°F / 36°C – 40°C

PRECIPITATION: Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 10 to 20% chance of showers.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 – 15 knots, falling light and variable at times across the Northern Bahamas.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 – 15 knots with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
84°F – 91°F / 29°C – 33°C 77°F – 82°F / 25°C – 28°C 96°F – 107°F / 36°C – 42°C

SKY CONDITIONS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Partly cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds

PRECIPITATION: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10 to 20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms
Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming east to southeast at 10 knots or less by the evening hours.

WINDS: Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, with higher gusts across the Southeast Bahamas.
