



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Sunday, April 26, 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EST.

<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A lingering surface trough in the vicinity of the Southeast Bahamas will continue to generate some shower activity through this afternoon. Meanwhile a ridge of high pressure is supporting a light breeze and tranquil weather conditions across the country.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> Gentle breezes and lingering moisture will keep occasional pops of showers, mainly in the Southeastern Islands, in the forecast, with a dry air mass capping any significant weather for the majority of the week ahead. A weak frontal boundary will drift and linger just north of the island chain by early Monday, crossing the Northern most islands by Monday afternoon and exiting the area by midweek with little fanfare. High pressure will become nestled over the area by Wednesday, keeping the light wind regime in place. Another late season cold front may move off the Florida coast by the end of the week, bringing in possible thunderstorm activity beginning late Thursday.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<b>Rip Currents:</b> There remains a marginal risk of rip currents for the Atlantic waters of the island chain. There is a slight risk of rip currents on the sheltered waters of the island chain. Beachgoers in these areas are urged to exercise caution.

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> South to southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times, veering southwest to west at 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours. <b>Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<b>All areas:</b> 10 – 30% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 knots or less. <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast at 10 to 15 knots falling occasionally 10 knots or less.

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the afternoon hours. Expect winds to veer south-southeast to south-southwest at 10 knots or less by nightfall. <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing 10 knots or less by the afternoon hours, falling light and variable at times.
