



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Thursday, September 10, 2026, FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are no public warnings in effect at this time.

Surface troughing and persistent tropical moisture will contribute to an elevated chance of showers and thunderstorms across the northern half of the country by this afternoon. Elsewhere, incoming Saharan dust and weak ridging will promote more stable conditions, despite occasional passing showers. Gentle to moderate breezes are expected across the Northern & Northwest Bahamas, while moderate to locally fresh breezes prevail elsewhere. Seas will remain smooth to slight in the Northern and Northwest Bahamas and slight to moderate across the Central and Southeast Bahamas.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: For the remainder of the workweek, a typical summertime weather pattern will prevail, supporting occasional afternoon showers and thunderstorms as tropical moisture continues to stream across the island chain. However, by Saturday, shower and thunderstorm chances increase once again when another frontal boundary dips into the Southeastern US, resulting in troughing across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, before merging with troughing associated with a wave across the Central Bahamas on Sunday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a slight to moderate risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas this afternoon.* These storms are capable of producing strong gusty winds, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and waterspout activity. *Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (11am – 4pm), as UV indices are expected to be in the high range across the Central and Southeast Bahamas.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30 – 40% chance of isolated afternoon showers or thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots or less, becoming light and variable at times.

PRECIPITATION: 30 – 40% chance of isolated showers or thunderstorms.
WINDS: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny today, becoming mainly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: 20 - 30% chance of a few isolated showers or thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 – 20 knots with slightly higher gusts at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 100°F – 106°F / 38°C – 41°C

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 - 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Central Bahamas: 20 - 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 12TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** 40 – 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Central Bahamas: 20 – 30% chance of few isolated showers or thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers or thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern Bahamas:** Southeasterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Elsewhere: a mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible.
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts occurring across the Southeast Bahamas.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms
Northern and Northwest Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less at night

WINDS: Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots.

Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots.
