



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Thursday, April 9, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>WARNING IN EFFECT:</b>	<p><b><i>A Severe Weather Watch</i></b> remains in effect for the portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas (Grand Bahama, Abaco) as well as portions of the Northwest Bahamas (Berry Islands, Northern Andros, New Providence, and Eleuthera) along with their adjacent waters and cays. <b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>An area of low pressure along the western flank of the island chain, together with a weakening frontal boundary and associated troughing, will keep weather across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas unsettled throughout most of the day, with conditions beginning to improve tonight as the low gradually shifts to the east into the Atlantic.</p> <p>Meanwhile, troughing across the Central and Southeast Bahamas will also support some isolated showers and thunderstorms, though activity across those areas will remain less widespread than across the Northern Islands. Winds are expected to remain fresh to strong with near gale-force gusts across the Northern Bahamas and portions of the Northwest Bahamas, while remaining light to gentle across the Central and Southeastern islands.</p> <p><b><i>Outlook:</i></b> By Friday, the frontal boundary will continue to weaken as it drifts into the Central Bahamas, leading to an uptick in showers across those islands, eventually reaching the Southeast Bahamas on Saturday. Following its passage, high pressure will build in its wake, leading to more stable conditions and fresh to strong breezes with near gale gusts across most of the island chain through the weekend and into early next week.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b><i>Flash Flooding:</i></b> There is a marginal to moderate risk of flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas across the Northern and portions of the Northwest Bahamas due to heavy and prolonged rainfall events. Residents are urged to exercise caution while traversing these areas, especially in areas already inundated with water from previous rainfall events.</p> <p><b><i>Rip Currents:</i></b> There is a <b>high</b> risk of rip currents for all Atlantic coastal waters and Passages across the whole island chain. Swimmers are advised to refrain from entering these waters and to exercise extreme caution when crossing the Glass Window Bridge on the island of Eleuthera until further notice.</p>

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Cloudy to overcast today, becoming partly cloudy during the overnight hours.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	50 to 70% chance of scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms through this evening, decreasing to 30 to 40% overnight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with <b><i>gusts to near gale force</i></b> through tonight.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Partly cloudy to cloudy today with some overcast periods today.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	40 to 60% chance of widely scattered showers with isolated thunderstorms through late afternoon, decreasing to 20 to 30% by this evening,		
<b>WINDS:</b>	East-northeast to east-southeast at 15 knots this morning, becoming northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots by the afternoon hours across the northern islands of the Northwest Bahamas (Northern Andros, Berry Islands, Northern Eleuthera) and variable at 10 knots or less across the remaining areas) and Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across all areas by the evening hours.

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mainly fair tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms through tonight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	Easterly at 10 knots or less through the afternoon hours, becoming northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots by the evening hours.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>
	78°F – 82°F / 26°C – 28°C	72°F – 75°F / 22°C – 25°C	N/A

<b>SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS</b> (INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	Mainly fair tonight, with a mix of sun and clouds expected tomorrow.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	20% chance of an isolated shower or two through tonight.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	East to southeast at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the evening hours.		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>
	80°F – 83°F / 26°C – 28°C	75°F – 77°F / 22°C – 25°C	N/A

<b>EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2026</b>			
<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny during the day becoming fair at night <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> Mix of sun and clouds during the morning hours, becoming partly sunny by afternoon and mainly fair at night. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> a mix of sun and clouds during the day, and variably cloudy at night.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> 10 to 20% chance of shower <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> 20 to 30% chance of showers. <i>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</i> 10 to 30% chance during the morning hours increasing to 20 to 40% chance by late evening.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale <i>Northwest Bahamas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with possible gusts to near gale (mainly across the northern islands of the Northwest Bahamas) during the morning hours, with winds Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts across the other areas. <i>Central Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by nightfall. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> East to southeast at 10 knots or less ahead of the front, shifting northeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts behind the front. Expect winds to become light and variable at times in the vicinity of the front.

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny, becoming variably cloudy at night. <i>Northwest and Central Bahamas:</i> Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night. <i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> Variably cloudy with gradual clearing, becoming mostly fair at night.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> 20 to 30% chance of showers with possible afternoon thunderstorms. <i>Elsewhere:</i> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by the evening hours. <i>Elsewhere:</i> Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts, increasing 20 to 25 knots with <i>potential gusts to near gale-force (mainly across the Northwest and Central Bahamas)</i> by the afternoon hours.

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<i>Southeast Bahamas:</i> 20 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm. <i>Elsewhere:</i> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>All areas:</i> Northeast to east at 20 to 25 knots with <b>gusts to near gale</b> .		
<b>TEMPERATURES:</b>	<b>MAXIMUM:</b>	<b>MINIMUM:</b>	<b>HEAT INDEX:</b>

<b>WINDS:</b>	<i>Northern Bahamas:</i> Northeasterly at 20 to 25 knots with <b>gusts to near gale force</b> , decreasing to 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts by the evening hours <i>Elsewhere:</i> Northeasterly at 20 to 25 knots with <b>gusts to near gale</b> .
