



## BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

**FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Tuesday, April 28, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.**

<b>GENERAL SITUATION:</b>	<p>A weak frontal boundary near the northern islands will continue to support pockets of shower activity across that area through this afternoon. Elsewhere, a ridge of high pressure dominates with generally stable conditions and light to gentle breezes.</p> <p><b>Outlook:</b> The frontal boundary is expected to dissipate overnight, with high pressure building in behind it. This will bring mostly stable conditions, warm temperatures, and gentle to moderate breezes through the end of the week across much of the country. However, a prefrontal trough could lead to some unsettled weather over parts of the Northern Bahamas from Thursday into Friday. At the same time, a mid- to upper-level disturbance may increase the chances of showers over the southernmost islands before moving out of the area. High pressure is then expected to reestablish itself over the weekend, supporting mainly dry conditions and very warm temperatures.</p>
<b>SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:</b>	<p><b>Rip Currents:</b> A <b>moderate</b> risk of rip currents exists along Atlantic-exposed beaches of the island chain, while a <b>slight</b> risk remains across sheltered waters. <b>Beachgoers are advised to exercise caution.</b></p> <p><b>UV Index:</b> The public is advised to exercise caution during peak sunshine hours (<b>11am – 3pm</b>), as UV indices are expected to be in the <b>high to very high</b> range.</p>

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 knots or less with occasional higher gusts, becoming southeast to south at 10 knots or less falling light and variable by the evening hours <b>Northwest Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 knots with higher gusts during the morning hours, decreasing to less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours. <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas by the afternoon hours.

<b>SKY CONDITIONS:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> Mix of sun and clouds during the day, becoming partly cloudy at night. <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> Partly cloudy to cloudy during the day, becoming variably cloudy at night. <b>Elsewhere:</b> Partly to mostly sunny during the day, becoming fair at night.		
<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<b>Northern &amp; Southeast Bahamas:</b> 20 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms. <b>Elsewhere:</b> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts during the evening hours. <b>Northwest Bahamas:</b> Southeast to south at 10 knots or less <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times across the Central Bahamas.

<b>PRECIPITATION:</b>	<b>Northern Bahamas:</b> 10 to 30% chance of showers or an isolated thunderstorm. <b>Elsewhere:</b> 10 to 20% chance of showers.		
<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> South to southwest at 10 knots or less, becoming southeast to south at 10 knots or less with higher gusts. <b>Central Bahamas:</b> East to southeast at 10 knots or less <b>Southeast Bahamas:</b> Easterly at 10 to 15 knots

<b>WINDS:</b>	<b>Northern and Northwest Bahamas:</b> Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable ahead of the front and North to Northeast at 15 to 20 knots behind the front. <b>Central and Southeast Bahamas:</b> Southerly at 10 to 15 knots, decreasing to 10 knots or less by the evening hours.
