



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Wednesday, May 13, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

A developing low associated with a frontal boundary across Central Florida will interact with abundant moisture over the area, giving rise to showers and thunderstorm activity over portions of the country throughout the day. Expect muggy and cloudy conditions to persist across most of the Bahamas through tonight, as this system drifts northeast along the southeastern US shoreline.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Trailing moisture from the low along with favorable atmospheric conditions will keep a wet and unsettled weather pattern across the majority of the Bahamas through to Thursday, as the front weakens just north of the Northern Bahamas. Expect gradual improvement with periodic cloudiness and showers beginning on Friday and heading into the weekend, as drier air filters into the area and the surface high rebuilds. By Sunday, a mid- to upper-level disturbance may develop over Atlantic waters east of the Bahamas, potentially making rainfall more widespread into early next week.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Rip Currents: There remains a **moderate** risk of rip currents for Atlantic waters of the Northern and Southeast Bahamas, with a **slight** risk over Atlantic waters for the remainder of the island chain. *Beachgoers and swimmers are urged to continue to exercise caution.*

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms today, increasing 30 – 50% by tonight.
WINDS: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots today, veering southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots tonight.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 81°F – 86°F / 27°C – 30°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 77°F / 23°C – 25°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms today, decreasing 20 – 30% by tonight.
WINDS: South to southwest at 10 to 15 knots today, veering southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots late tonight.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 81°F – 86°F / 27°C – 30°C **MINIMUM:** 73°F – 77°F / 23°C – 25°C **HEAT INDEX:** N/A

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: A mix of sun and clouds today, turning partly cloudy to cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots today, veering south to southwest at 10 knots or less by tonight.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 93°F – 98°F / 34°C – 37°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny today, turning partly cloudy tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of showers.
WINDS: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots today, falling light and variable by tonight
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 84°F – 90°F / 29°C – 32°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C **HEAT INDEX:** 95°F – 98°F / 35°C – 37°C

**EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 14TH MAY 2026:**

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern Bahamas: Partly sunny, turning mostly fair at night. Northwest and Central Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy. Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning partly cloudy at night.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern Bahamas: 10 – 20% chance of showers. Northwest, Central and Southeast Bahamas: 30 – 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms, decreasing 20 – 40% by nightfall. Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable by nightfall.		
WINDS:	Northwest and Central Bahamas: Southwest to west at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times. Southeast Bahamas: South-southwest to west-southwest at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable by the evening hours.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 82°F – 90°F / 28°C – 32°C	MINIMUM: 72°F – 77°F / 22°C – 25°C	HEAT INDEX: 95°F – 98°F / 35°C – 37°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 15TH MAY 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS:	Northern and Northwest and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny to sunny, turning mostly fair at night. Central Bahamas: Partly cloudy to cloudy.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern, Northwest and Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers. Central Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms		
WINDS:	All areas: Variable at 10 knots or less during the day, becoming east-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times by nightfall.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 82°F – 90°F / 28°C – 32°C	MINIMUM: 72°F – 77°F / 22°C – 25°C	HEAT INDEX: 95°F – 98°F / 35°C – 37°C

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.		
WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots. Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 84°F – 88°F / 29°C – 31°C	MINIMUM: 72°F – 77°F / 22°C – 25°C	HEAT INDEX: N/A

TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C	MINIMUM: 70°F – 77°F / 21°C – 25°C	HEAT INDEX: N/A

WINDS:	Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing 15 to 20 knots by nightfall. Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots, decreasing 10 to 15 knots by nightfall.		
TEMPERATURES:	MAXIMUM: 82°F – 88°F / 28°C – 31°C	MINIMUM: 70°F – 77°F / 21°C – 25°C	HEAT INDEX: N/A
