



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EDT, Wednesday, September 9, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EDT.

An abundance of moist air continue to induce showers and thunderstorms throughout the Bahamas while a stationary frontal boundary sits just north of the northern islands and its associated trough lies south of the Southeast Bahamas. High pressure ridge is supporting gentle to fresh winds and moderate seas throughout the archipelago.

GENERAL SITUATION: **Outlook:** For the remainder of the workweek, a typical summertime weather pattern will prevail, supporting occasional afternoon showers and thunderstorms as tropical moisture continues to stream across the island chain. However, by Saturday, shower and thunderstorm chances once again are forecasted to increase when another frontal boundary dips into the Southeastern US, resulting in troughing across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, before merging with troughing associated with a wave across the Central Bahamas on Sunday.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES: **Severe Thunderstorm Risk:** *There is a slight to moderate risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms across portions of the Bahamas today.* These storms are capable of producing **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**. *Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.*

UV Index: Members of the public are advised to wear protective clothing and sunscreen and seek shaded areas while outside during peak sunshine hours (**11am – 4pm**), as UV indices are expected to be in the **high** range.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS (INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this morning becoming partly to mostly cloudy this afternoon
PRECIPITATION: 10 to 20% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm this morning increasing 20 to 50% chance of widely scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms this afternoon.
WINDS: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling 10 knots or less tonight.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 36°F – 39°F / 96°C – 102°C

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS (INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly sunny this morning becoming partly to mostly cloudy this afternoon
PRECIPITATION: 20 to 30% chance of isolated showers or a thunderstorm this morning increasing 30 to 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms this afternoon.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 37°F – 40°F / 98°C – 104°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS (INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy through tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 60% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 knots, gusting at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 37°F – 40°F / 98°C – 104°C



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SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy through tonight.
PRECIPITATION: 30 to 50% chance of scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots, gusting at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C **HEAT INDEX:** 37°F – 40°F / 98°C – 104°C

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK:

Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven (7) days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR THURSDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.
Central & Southeast Bahamas: Mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 - 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: Southeasterly at 10 to 15 knots.
WINDS: **Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 TO 20 knots.
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 to 20 knots.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR FRIDAY 11TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds.
PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 - 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Central Bahamas: 20 - 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers and thunderstorms.
WINDS: **Northern & Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 98°F – 104°F / 37°C – 40°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SATURDAY 12TH SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds, turning mostly fair at night.
PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Northern Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming variable during the afternoon hours, and east to southeast at 10 knots or less during the evening hours
WINDS: **Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts, increasing to 15 to 20 knots by the evening.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 13TH SEPTEMBER, 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Partly cloudy to cloudy.
Elsewhere: a mix of sun and clouds
PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible.
Elsewhere: 30 to 50% chance of showers
WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts occurring across the Southeast Bahamas.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** 88°F – 91°F / 31°C – 33°C **MINIMUM:** 75°F – 82°F / 24°C – 28°C **HEAT INDEX:** 96°F – 102°F / 36°C – 39°C



EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 14TH, SEPTEMBER 2026.

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly cloudy.

PRECIPITATION: All areas: 10 to 30% chance of isolated showers and thunderstorms

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, becoming northeast to east at 10 knots or less at night

Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots.

Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots.

Central & Southeast Bahamas: East-northeasterly at 15 knots.
