



BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST

FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR TODAY, TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 A.M. EST, Wednesday, December 3, 2025. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 12:00 P.M. EST.

WARNING IN EFFECT:	<i>There are currently no warnings in effect at this time. For marine information, please see our marine forecast.</i>
GENERAL SITUATION:	Troughing, associated with an approaching cold front near the Northern Bahama Islands along with a surface trough coupled with low level moisture east of the southern islands will generate some shallow shower activity across portions of the country. Outlook: The front is anticipated to stall across the Central Bahama islands and gradually dissipate through Thursday. High pressure will then rebuild over most of the country for the remainder of the week, maintaining stable and mostly dry conditions. Nonetheless, persistent low-level troughing near the Southeast Bahamas will keep the chance of a few spotty showers in place through the end of the work week.
SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:	There is a marginal to moderate risk for patches of fog during the early morning hours along forested, marshy and coastal areas therefore are motorists advised to exercise caution when traversing these areas. There is a moderate risk of rip currents along all Atlantic coastal beaches, hence beachgoers and swimmers are asked to remain vigilant.

PRECIPITATION:	20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northeasterly at 10 to 15 knots increasing to 15 knots with higher gusts by tonight.

WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times. Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times. Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 knots with higher gusts.

PRECIPITATION:	20% chance of showers across the Southeastern Bahamas. Elsewhere, 10% or less chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable. Shifting southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots across the Northern Bahamas but 10 knots or less across the Northwest Bahamas. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Northeast to east at 15 to 20 knots.

PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20% chance of showers. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10-20% chance of showers'		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southerly at 10 knots or less. Central Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable. Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.

SKY CONDITIONS:	A mix of sun and clouds during the day, increasing cloudiness across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas during the late evening into nighttime. Central and Southeast Bahamas: Partly sunny during the day becoming mostly fair at night with increasing cloudiness across the Central Bahamas overnight.		
PRECIPITATION:	10-30% chance of showers across the area		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: South-southeast to south-southeast at 15 knots with 15 to 20 knots. Shifting south to southwest by nightfall. Central Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots. Southeast Bahamas: Southeasterly at 15 knots with higher gusts.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY 8 TH DECEMBER, 2025.			
SKY CONDITIONS:	Partly cloudy to cloudy becoming cloudy to occasionally overcast across the Northern and Northwest Bahamas by midday. Increasing cloudiness across the remainder of the country by nightfall.		
PRECIPITATION:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: 20-30% chance of showers during the early morning hours increasing 40-60% chance of showers with isolated thunderstorms possible by midday. Central and Southeast Bahamas: 10-20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern Bahamas: Southwest to west at 15 to 20 knots shifting west to northwest at 15 to 20 knots with higher knots by midday. Northwest Bahamas: Southwesterly at 10 to 15 knots shifting westerly at 10 to 15 knots with occasional gusts by midday. Central Bahamas: Variable at 10 knots or less. Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots with occasional gusts. Becoming light and variable by nightfall.

PRECIPITATION:	20-40% chance of showers with the chance of an isolated thunderstorm across the Northwest and Central Bahamas. Elsewhere: 10-20% chance of showers.		
WINDS:	Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Northerly at 15 knots with higher gusts. Central Bahamas: North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots becoming more Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots by afternoon hours. Southeast Bahamas: Light and variable. Becoming Northerly at 10 knots or less by midday.
