



BAHAMAS MARINE FORECAST

MARINE FORECASTS FOR THE BAHAMAS ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EST FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27TH, 2026, FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECASTS WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EST TOMORROW.

There is a *slight to moderate risk* of rip currents for the Atlantic coastal waters of the Southeast Bahamas.

Swimmers are advised to exercise caution when entering these waters.

WARNINGS:

There is a *slight risk* of rip currents for the Atlantic waters of the Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Surface ridge continues to steer moisture over the archipelago, increasing showers over the islands tonight through tomorrow. By Sunday, a cold front is expected to move into the Northern Bahamas increasing shower and possible thunderstorm activity, before stalling across the Northwest Bahamas. The boundary is expected to gradually weaken and move out of the area by midweek, winds are expected to increase as a high builds and creates rough sea conditions.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

None.

WINDS:

Southeasterly at 10 knots tonight, becoming south to southwest tomorrow with higher gusts.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in nearshore and opens waters, 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

GULF STREAM:

3 feet or less through tomorrow.

SWELLS:

Light southeasterly swells in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

WEATHER:

Chance of showers tonight with a possible thunderstorm tomorrow.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

None.

WINDS:

Southeast to south at 10 to 15 knots tonight through tomorrow, falling light and variable at times.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in nearshore and opens waters, 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

SWELLS:

Light southeasterly swells in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

WEATHER:

Chance of showers tonight with a possible thunderstorm tomorrow.

CENTRAL BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

There is a *small craft caution* in effect for Atlantic waters.

WINDS:

East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts through tomorrow.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in nearshore and opens waters, 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

SWELLS:

Light to moderate easterly swells in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

WEATHER:

Chance of showers tonight with a possible thunderstorm tomorrow.

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

ADVISORY:

There is a *small craft caution* in effect for open waters.

There is a *small craft advisory* in effect for Atlantic waters.

WINDS:

Easterly at 15 to 20 knots tonight with higher gusts, becoming east to southeast tomorrow.

LOCAL SEAS:

3 feet or less in nearshore waters, 3 to 5 feet in opens waters, 5 to 7 feet in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

SWELLS:

Light to moderate easterly swells in Atlantic waters through tomorrow.

WEATHER:

Chance of showers tonight with a possible thunderstorm tomorrow.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY, 1ST MARCH, 2026:

ADVISORY: There is a *small craft advisory* in effect for Atlantic waters of the Southeast Bahamas.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** North to northeast at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.
Central Bahamas: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
Southeast Bahamas: Southeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

SEAS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** 3 feet or less in nearshore and opens waters, 3 to 5 feet in Atlantic waters.
Southeast Bahamas: 3 feet or less in nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet in opens waters, 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters.

PRECIPITATION: **Southeast Bahamas:** Chance of scattered showers.
Elsewhere: Slight chance of an isolated shower.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR MONDAY, 2ND MARCH, 2026:

ADVISORY: There is a *small craft advisory* in effect for all Atlantic waters.

WINDS: **Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas:** Northeasterly at 15 to 20 knots with higher gusts.
Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots with higher gusts.

SEAS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 3 feet or less in nearshore waters, 3 to 5 feet in opens waters, 5 to 7 feet in Atlantic waters.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 3 feet or less in nearshore waters, 2 to 4 feet in opens waters, 4 to 6 feet in Atlantic waters.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern Bahamas:** Slight chance of an isolated shower.
Elsewhere: Chance of scattered showers.
