BAHAMAS PUBLIC FORECAST FOR TONIGHT AND THE NEXT SIX (6) DAYS, ISSUED BY THE BAHAMAS DEPARTMENT OF METEOROLOGY AT 6:00 P.M. EDT, Friday, September 4, 2026. THE NEXT SCHEDULED FORECAST WILL BE ISSUED AT 6:00 A.M. EDT TOMORROW.

WARNING IN EFFECT:

There are currently no public warnings in effect at this time.

Ample moisture pooling across the northern territories will interact with a mid-level trough just north of the area. These features will sustain periodic waves of showers and thunderstorms over portions of the Northern and Northwest Bahamas, with possible bouts of inclement weather as the trough dips southward by late Saturday afternoon. An inbound tropical wave is anticipated to enter the Southeast Bahamas overnight, producing some short-lived thunderstorms while elevating shower chances slightly over the southern half of the country on Saturday.

GENERAL SITUATION:

Outlook: Moisture levels will increase across the country as the tropical wave continues to move westward, merging with existing moisture pooling just south of a frontal boundary across the southeastern United States through the weekend. As a result, weather conditions are expected to become increasingly active across the northern half of the country on Sunday. Expect a generally cloudy, wet, and humid pattern to persist through much of the week, as these features continue to influence the region.

SPECIAL WEATHER NOTES:

Severe Thunderstorm Risk: *There is a slight to moderate* risk for a few isolated strong to severe thunderstorms *across* portions of the **Northern and Northwest Bahamas** on Saturday. These storms could produce **strong gusty winds**, frequent lightning, heavy downpours, and **waterspout activity**. **Therefore, the public is urged to remain updated on all severe weather warnings issued by the Bahamas Department of Meteorology.**

Flood Risk: There is a *slight* risk for flooding in low-lying, flood-prone and urban areas during heavy or prolonged rainfall periods, especially over portions of the **Northern Bahamas**.

NORTHERN BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING GRAND BAHAMA, ABACO, BIMINI & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy to cloudy.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 30% chance of showers with thunderstorms tonight, increasing 30 – 50% on Saturday.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 knots tonight, falling light and variable on Saturday.

NORTHWEST BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING NEW PROVIDENCE, ANDROS, THE BERRY ISLANDS, ELEUTHERA & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Partly cloudy tonight. Expect a mix of sun and clouds on Saturday.
PRECIPITATION: 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
WINDS: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
90°F – 92°F / 32°C – 33°C 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C 100°F – 106°F / 38°C – 41°C

CENTRAL BAHAMAS
(INCLUDING EXUMA, CAT ISLAND, LONG ISLAND, SAN SALVADOR, RUM CAY & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair tonight. Expect a mix of sun and clouds on Saturday.
PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.
WINDS: East-northeast to east-southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.
TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
90°F – 93°F / 32°C – 34°C 75°F – 79°F / 24°C – 26°C 100°F – 106°F / 38°C – 41°C

SOUTHEAST BAHAMAS

(INCLUDING INAGUA, ACKLINS, CROOKED ISLAND, MAYAGUANA, RAGGED ISLAND & ADJACENT WATERS):

SKY CONDITIONS: Mostly fair at first, becoming partly cloudy during the overnight hours. Expect a mix of sun and clouds on Saturday.

PRECIPITATION: 10 – 30% chance of showers tonight, increasing to a 20 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms beginning early Saturday.

WINDS: Northeast to east at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable at times.

TROPICAL WEATHER OUTLOOK: Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next seven days.

EXTENDED FORECAST FOR THE BAHAMAS FOR SUNDAY 6TH SEPTEMBER, 2026:

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds,

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers and thunderstorms
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming variable at less than 10 knots by the afternoon hours.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less by the afternoon mainly across the Central Bahamas.

SKY CONDITIONS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Partly cloudy.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: A mix of sun and clouds.

PRECIPITATION: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** 30 to 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: 20% chance of showers and isolated thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, becoming easterly at 10 knots or less by the evening
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, falling to 10 knots or less across the Central Bahamas by the afternoon

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 to 40% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** East to southeast at 10 knots or less.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 10 to 15 knots, with higher gusts in the Southeast Bahamas.

PRECIPITATION: **All areas:** 20 to 30% chance of showers and isolated afternoon thunderstorms.

WINDS: **Northern and Northwest Bahamas:** Easterly at 10 to 15 knots, falling light and variable.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 15 knots.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Easterly at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: Easterly at 10 to 15 knots.

TEMPERATURES: **MAXIMUM:** **MINIMUM:** **HEAT INDEX:**
88°F – 93°F / 31°C – 34°C 74°F – 81°F / 24°C – 27°C 98°F – 102°F / 37°C – 39°C

SKY CONDITIONS: All areas: Partly cloudy to cloudy

PRECIPITATION: Northern, Northwest and Central Bahamas: 30 – 40% chance of showers with thunderstorms.
Southeast Bahamas: 10 – 30% chance of showers with possible thunderstorms.

WINDS: Northern and Northwest Bahamas: Southeast to south at 10 knots or less, falling light and variable at times.
Central and Southeast Bahamas: East to southeast at 15 knots.
